Sickness and Diarrhoea

On sunny days please apply sun cream to your child before coming to nursery. If your child is at nursery all day, please supply a named bottle of sun cream in your child's bag and staff will reapply at lunchtime.

You **must** tell staff on reception if anyone different is collecting your child from nursery. We will be unable to send children home with people who are unknown to us and we will ring you if we are unsure. This is a **safeguarding** issue.

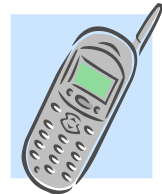
