If anyone in your house has covid symptoms of a cough, high temperature or loss of taste or smell, please contact 111 or 119 to book them a test. You will not be able to bring your child back to nursery unless the person with symptoms has a negative result or you have all isolated for 14 days and no one else in the house has become ill. If someone tests positive please let us know. For further advice please call the office.

Head Lice

Head lice is a very common problem in nursery and school. To help to try to avoid it, please tie your child's hair back and check their hair daily in order to catch them early. Combing your child's hair with a head lice comb and conditioner is a cheaper way to get rid of them rather than expensive solutions. If you have any queries please speak to any staff member.
