If your child is moving up to the main nursery in September you will shortly receive a letter inviting you to our new parents evening Wednesday 20th June. Please let us know if you are able to attend.

You child will meet their new Keyworker during their sessions in the coming weeks, and enjoy stay and plays in the main nursery.

We will allocate the same sessions of either morning or afternoon unless you let us know you would like to change for September

30 hours nursery childcare for children aged 3 years.

If you and your partner earn the equivalent of 16 hours at the National Minimum wage you should qualify for 30 hours childcare in the term **after your child turns 3 years**. Please visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. If you qualify please speak to Mandy or Claire on Reception about your sessions for September. You need your code by **31st August** to qualify for **September**.
