#### **Snack Money**

Everyday, we provide snacks, milk and water for your child. We please ask for 15 hour parents to pay £2.50 per week and 30 hour parents to pay £5 per week towards the cost of your child's snacks.

This allows us to provide good quality, healthy food for your child and occasionally, we use snack money for themed resources and treats.

From September you will be able to pay for your child's snack contribution on the WEDUC App under Payments.

You can also still pay in an envelope with your child's name on at the beginning of each week, or month. Thank you.

### Weduc Payments

You can now make Weduc payments for any additional hours you are invoiced for. This is new to the office so please bear with us while we get this up and running, You can still pay via the Tax Free Childcare. Thank you

#### Illness

If your child is at all ill please ring the school and let us know they are poorly.

If your child comes to nursery wearing wellies, please can we ask that they bring a separate spare pair of shoes to wear whilst being inside. The nursery can not be held responsible for any lost items, so please put your child's name in all items of clothing, bags and shoes. It is your responsibility to please check your child's bag when you drop off or collect your child.

## Reminder

Please can you remember to keep us updated with your latest contact details, especially the CORRECT TELEPHONE NUMBERS as it is important we get hold of you as soon as possible in the case of EMERGENCY. ## Collecting children

You must please tell staff on reception if anyone different is collecting your child from nursery. We will ask for a password and their phone number. We will be unable to send children home with people who are unknown to us and we will ring you if we are unsure. This is a safeguarding issue.

# Sun cream

On sunny days please apply sun cream to your child before coming to nursery. If your child is at nursery all day, please apply an all day sun cream or supply a named bottle of sun cream in your child's bag which can be re-applied at lunchtime.

# **Session times**

Please be <u>on time</u> when bringing and collecting your child. Children arriving and leaving at different times can cause disruption for all the other children. If you need to collect early for a particular reason, please let reception know in advance. The breakfast club door closes at **8.20am** and the main door closes at **8.40am** and **12.40pm**. Collection times are from **11.20am** and **3.15pm**, to allow parents to get to other schools.
