## Ronald Tree Nursery School: Parental Questionnaire Feedback Report 2022-2023 Academic Year


The questionnaire was issued to 118 families via the Reach More Parents App and 45 questionnaires (38%) were completed; questionnaires were completed on an even spread across the three year groups, N2, N1 and E2.

The questionnaire asked parents to consider the revised thirteen statements from the Ofsted Parentview questionnaire, relating to their perceptions of their own and their child's experiences of Ronald Tree Nursery School and the majority of statements were to be rated on a range from Strongly Agree to Strongly Disagree plus not applicable in some cases. Having spoken to some of our parents afterwards they found the fact that the responses were not all the same format confusing; however this mirrors the Ofsted Parentview website and is the same system parents would use if they completed their questionnaire online.

The questionnaire also asked if parents would recommend the school to other parents, asked for any further comments and suggestions and finally asked if parents would support an increase in the snack fund contributions to £3 per week for each 15 hours a child attends.

## **Statements**

- 1. My Child is happy at this school; 33 respondents 'strongly agreed' (73%) and twelve respondents 'agreed' (27%).
- 2. My child feels safe at this school: 34 respondents 'strongly agreed' (76%), ten respondents 'agreed' (22%) and one respondent 'didn't know' (2%).
- 3. The school makes sure the pupils are well behaved: 22 respondents 'strongly agreed' (49%), 21 respondents 'agreed' (47%) and two respondents 'didn't know' (2%).
- 4. My child has been bullied & the school dealt with the bullying quickly & effectively: 2 respondents 'agreed' (4%), 2 respondents 'disagreed' (4%) and 41 respondents 'not applicable' (92%).
- 5. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year: 18 respondents 'strongly agreed' (40%), 22 respondents 'agreed' (49%) and five respondents 'disagreed' (11%).
- 6. My concerns have been dealt with properly: 20 respondents 'strongly agreed' (44%), 9 respondents 'agreed' (20%) three respondents 'disagreed' (7%) and 13 respondents 'not applicable' (29%).
- 7. My child has special educational needs, the school gives them the support they need to succeed: 7 respondents 'strongly agreed' (16%), two respondents 'agreed' (4%) one respondent 'disagreed' (2%) and 35 respondents 'not applicable' (78%).
- 8. The school has high expectations for my child: 16 respondents 'strongly agreed' (36%), 17 respondents 'agreed' (38%) six respondents 'disagreed' (13%) and six respondents 'didn't know' (13%).
- 9. My child does well at this school: 28 respondents 'strongly agreed' (62%), 16 respondents 'agreed' (36%) and one respondent 'didn't know' (2%).
- 10. The school lets me know how my child is doing: 30 respondents 'strongly agreed' (67%), 13 respondents 'agreed' (29%) and two respondents 'disagreed' (4%).
- 11. There is a good range of subjects available at this school: 21 respondents 'strongly agreed' (47%), 17 respondents 'agreed' (38%) and seven respondents 'didn't know' (16%).
- 12. My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school: 21 respondents 'strongly agreed' (47%), 13 respondents 'agreed' (29%), two respondents 'disagreed' (4%) and nine respondents 'didn't know' (20%).
- 13. This school supports my child's wider development: 28 respondents 'strongly agreed' (62%) and 12 respondents 'agreed' (27%), one respondent 'disagreed' (4%) and four respondents 'didn't know' (9%).
- 14. I would recommend this school to another parent: 45 respondents 'strongly agreed' (100%).
- 15. I would support an increase in snack to £3 per week: 37 respondents 'strongly agreed' (82%) and eight respondents 'disagreed' (18%).



## **Statement Feedback Analysis**

The vast majority of respondents 'strongly agreed', 'agreed', or found statements didn't apply to their child/experience of the school. Where parents had chosen not to make their survey anonymous and they had disagreed with statements the school made further enquiries with the parents. In the majority of these cases it is believed this was not from dissatisfaction but that the parents did not fully understand the grammatical phrasing of the statement and the implication of the response; or alternatively how the statement applied to a child in nursery school rather than a primary or secondary school. This had not been an issue in previous years when the previous Ofsted Parentview statements and responses were used. In future years senior managers might seek to alter the questions to better reflect the Early Years Foundation Stage.

There was an even split of questionnaires between children in years N2 (leaving to go to school in September 2023), year N1 (going to school in September 2024) and year E2 (going to school in September 2025). 21 questionnaires (46%) were returned from parents whose children attended for the universal 15 hours per week in the main nursery and 14 questionnaires (31%) from parents whose children attended for 30 hours or more. Ten questionnaires (22%) was returned from a parent with a child in the Teddy Bear Room.

**Recommendation of Ronald Tree Nursery School:** 100% of respondents said they would recommend the nursery to another parent.

## **Further Comments**

Parents were invited to leave further comments or suggestions. 9 parents did so (20%). Many parents also sent thank you cards (including some of those with children in Year N1) or left messages on the school Facebook page, Tapestry or Reach More Parents App. Without exception these comments thanked the nursery staff for the high quality of provision their children had experienced at Ronald Tree and these are listed on the following pages
