### Returning children September 2024

If your child is returning to nursery in September we will allocate the same sessions unless you let us know.

30 hours nursery childcare for children aged 3 years/15 hours for children aged 2 years.

If you and your partner earn the equivalent of 16 hours at the National Minimum wage you should qualify for 15/30 hours childcare in the term after your child turns 2/3 years. Please visit [www.childcarechoices.gov.uk](http://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk). If you qualify please speak to Christina or Mandy on Reception about your sessions for September. You need your code by **31st August** to qualify for **September**.

Please pay £2.50 each week or £10 monthly if your child attend 15 hours and £5 per week if they attend 30 hours. If you would like more snack money envelopes please collect on reception. Thank you.
